NOTIFICATION

The National Law University Delhi runs its Ph.D. Programme as per the Ph.D. Regulations approved by the competent authority. Admission to the Ph.D. Programme of the National Law University Delhi is based on following Regulations:

- i) The admission shall be through a two-stage selection process, which includes (1) written entrance test and (2) the evaluation of research proposals followed by interview/ viva-voce. In the final selection of candidates, a weightage of 70% shall be given to the entrance test and 30% shall be given to the results of evaluation of research proposals and interview/viva-voce.
- ii) 50% of the questions for the entrance test shall be relating to Research Methodology and the remaining 50% shall be from different areas of law. The candidate shall secure a minimum of 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST/differently abled candidates) in the entrance test to qualify for the second stage. Candidates equal to three times the number of available seats will be shortlisted for the second stage, based on the results of the entrance test.
- iii) The candidate should also secure a minimum of 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST/differently abled candidates) in the evaluation of research proposals and interview/viva-voce to qualify for the final selection.

Based on the above provisions, following candidates have been selected by the Research Advisory Committee, who will defend their research proposals before the Doctoral Committee on December 30, 2020 for final admission to the Ph.D. Programme.
