CALL FOR APPLICATIONS – ASSOCIATE (DRAFTING)

The Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India has constituted a Committee to recommend reforms in criminal laws in India. The Committee seeks to review criminal laws in a principled, effective and efficient manner, informed by constitutional values of justice, dignity and the inherent worth of the individual. Towards this end, the Committee seeks to engage an experienced person with proven competence in legislative drafting.

POSITION:

Associate (Drafting) to support the research and ancillary activities of the Committee.

DURATION:

The engagement shall be for a period of six months (extendable by another six months), starting immediately.

RESPONSIBILITY:

1. The Associate shall primarily be required to conduct legislative drafting in provisions relating to Criminal Law, including the Indian Penal Code 1860, the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 and the Indian Evidence Act 1872
2. The Associate shall be assigned any other such responsibility as the Committee may deem fit.

ELIGIBILITY:

Graduate in a discipline of Law (LL.B. or B.A. LL.B.) with a demonstrable experience of legislative drafting. The prior experience is highly expected. This will be the major criteria of selection.

RENUMERATION:

The remuneration shall be in lumpsum at the end of the engagement. The amount shall be commensurate to experience.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

All Applicants are required to apply by **July 17, 2020** latest. Applications beyond this date and time will not be considered.

The applicants fully qualified are required to submit their **CV, a Statement of Purpose (maximum 300 words)** and **a writing sample** (published/unpublished, sole authorship, preferably on Criminal Law) to opportunities@nludelhi.ac.in with the subject **Application for the Post of Associate (Drafting)**.

The selected candidates shall be required to appear for an interview.
