ABOUT THE UNCITRAL ASIA PACIFIC DAY

The United Nations Commission on International Trade Law ("UNCITRAL") was established 50 years ago by the United Nations General Assembly Resolution 2205 (XXI) adopted on 17 December 1966, which, in recognizing that disparities in national laws governing international trade created obstacles to the flow of trade, regarded the Commission as the vehicle by which the United Nations could play a more active role in reducing or removing these obstacles. To annually celebrate this historical resolution, UNCITRAL-RCAP established the UNCITRAL Asia Pacific Day in 2014. Each year, reputable universities across the region join and it continues to evolve in the years ahead. Asia Pacific Day 2016 is organized with a focus on the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods (Vienna, 1980) ("CISG").
