Prof. Iain MacNeil

Head of the School of Law at the University of Glasgow. He joined the School in 2003 and was appointed to the Alexander Stone Chair of Commercial Law in 2005. He is a graduate of the Universities of Glasgow (LLB) and Edinburgh (PhD). He took up his first academic appointment at the University of Aberdeen in 1993 following completion of his PhD. He is a member of the editorial board of the Capital Markets Law Journal.

Prof. Christian Tams

Christian J. Tams joined the Law School in 2008, having previously been an assistant professor at the Walther Schücking Institute of International Law at the University of Kiel. At Glasgow, he convenes the LL.M. in international law and leads the research group on International Law, Conflict and Security. He studied law at the universities of Kiel, Lyon III and Cambridge (LLM, 2000; PhD, 2004), and is a qualified German lawyer.

Prof. Irene-marié Esser

Irene-marié Esser is a Senior Lecturer in Commercial Law at the University of Glasgow, a Professor Extraordinarius at the University of South Africa (UNISA) and a Visiting Professor at the Open University, UK. She obtained her LLB at Stellenbosch University (2001), her LLM at the University of Aberdeen, Scotland (2003) and her LLD at UNISA (2008). She is also an admitted attorney of the High Court of South Africa.

Prof. Dr. Harpreet Kaur - Programme Director

Dr. Harpreet Kaur is Professor of Law at NLU Delhi, as well as the faculty-in-charge for certificate and diploma courses on Competition Policy and Law. She is a Fulbright Scholar in Residence and has served as Chair Professor of Indian Studies at Leibniz University, Hannover, Germany for a semester. She was selected for the International Visitor Leadership Programme on Competition Law sponsored by US State Government in 2015. She teaches Corporate and Securities Laws and Competition Law.
