Vertical Interaction Course on “Victimological Application to Police and Criminal Justice Administration”

Concept Note

There have been significant developments in the recent times having a bearing on the policing in India. Both the legislature and judicial developments with regard to policing have marked the beginning of a new era and therefore the policing has grown to be a more challenging job now. Further, at the present juncture it becomes imperative to educate and train the Police Officials on various facets of Victimology such as victim's rights, victim population, crime and its effects on victims in the Criminal Justice System.

Against this backdrop, this five day vertical interaction course to be attended by senior level police officials aims at providing some meaningful insight into some of the most crucially important areas of Victimology from policing perspective. The objectives of the course are:

1. To familiarize Police Officials about current developments in Victimology
2. To sensitize Police Officials about needs of Crime Victims
3. To impart knowledge and information about recent judgements of the Supreme Court of India with respect to Crime Victims and their Rights.
4. To highlight the significance of Victimological Survey and Crime Reporting.
